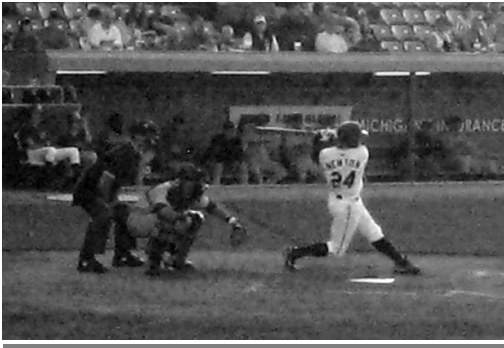

SBC churches in Kentucky, Mississippi, and Tennessee are asked to fill three 20-foot ocean shipping containers with In-Home Care Kits to be shipped to Sub-Saharan Africa where the HIV/Aids crisis is affecting a large segment of the population—especially children.

At present time there are 22.5 million adults and children who are living with the HIV virus. Many thousand more die each year from cancer, TB, malaria and other life-ending diseases. More often than not the only care they will receive is at home.

The Baptist Global Response In-Home Care Kit contains medical and hygiene supplies provided to assist caregivers taking care of home-bound, terminally ill patients. Items in this Kit will ease the suffering of the one affected by illness and make the caregiver's task much easier. (Many homes are child-headed households where both parents have died and older children take care of younger ones.)

Instructions for the Kits are available at the information desk out front and in the church office. If you cannot put a kit together, you may give by putting the gift in an envelope marked In-Home Care Kit. Please PRAY for the people of Sub-Saharan Africa.
