I was reading Matthew the other day and came to a passage where Jesus says "my yoke is easy and my burden is light" (Matt 11:30). I was wondering how this could be true considering Jesus also said "any of you who does not give up everything he has cannot be my disciple" (Luke 14:33). I think Jesus is saying that once we start peeling that other stuff out of our lives, then following him wholeheartedly won't seem so hard. It might even be easy.

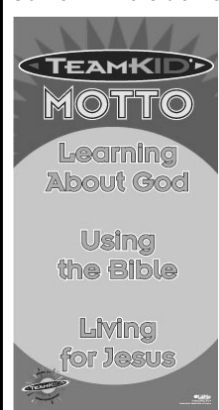
