That's why it bothers me that I have gotten to know some of you very well and some of you not quite at all. And with new people and guests coming our way all the time, I suppose I'll never catch up. I may never get to know all of you at the level I'd like. But over time as I visit around and as we work together, I do get closer and closer with you. This has been one of the most enriching experiences of my life through the years as a pastor.

Now let me ask you a very important question. Do you feel that you could call on me when the need arises? I'll bet that your answer to that question would depend largely on how well we've gotten to know each other over the time that I have been here as your pastor. I've had the privilege of ministering to some of you in some very important ways, and so you probably feel confident about calling on me. But some of you might not feel that way at all, because we just haven't had the opportunity of really connecting.

Please don't get the idea that something has happened lately that has caused me to wonder about these things. It's just that with the large crowd that I look out over on any given Sunday, I realize that some of you could feel left out and disconnected. I suppose some of that feeling is inevitable between us as pastor and congregation. So I just think it's important to say every once in a while that I love you, and that I have a strong desire to serve you when you feel that you need your pastor. Don't let the fact that we in particular haven't gotten to know each other very well stop you from calling when I could be of service to you. And then when you do call, we'll probably feel like friends forever. And in Christ we certainly are.
